Applications

- When planting seedlings foliar spray Wormswork Liquid gold at the rate of 1 part to 20 parts water weekly to run-off. The worm liquid is not a concentrated nutrient source but rather a fungistatic fungicide that prevents the incidence of grey mould (Botrytis) and root rot (Sclerotinia) often caused by poor air circulation. The worm liquid is rich in micro-organisms that accelerate nutrient breakdown, uptake and rapid root development, even when applied as a foliar spray. It is also rich in potassium for flower health and chlorophyll manufacture; essential under lights. Optimum uptake above 20 degrees C and below 30 degrees C.
- When fruit sets you can continue to use Wormswork Liquid gold as a foliar spray at 20 parts water to 1 part wormswork liquid gold at any stage during the growth cycle; no agitation is required as there is no sediment. The liquid can be used right up to harvest as there is no withholding period and no defoliation. Also ideal for in-line fertigators or drippers, as there is no residue or nutrient lockup.

- **Significant root development without canopy development, due to only 1.8% N, but rich micronutrients.**
- **Roots develop even in winter at > 12°C.**
