How does **Wormswork** work with Landscapes & Garden Maintenance?

- **Wormswork** Composite mix can be used at planting time to improve plant establishment and soil moisture retention by stimulating vigorous plant and root growth and increasing plant survival rates.
- **Wormswork** Composite mix can be used with great effect on soils that are known to have had root knot nematode (RKN) infestations, as the high incidence of predatory nematodes evidenced in the Soil Web analysis indicate a high incidence of nematodes that predate on the RKN.

Applications — Solid

When planting container grown stock use **Wormswork** 1 to 3 litres in the planting hole without adding any further media. This will assure adequate moisture retention and provide a significant organic buffer for nutrient exchange.

- Significant root development without canopy development, due to only 1.8% N, but rich micronutrients.
- Wormswork contains virtually no nitrogen or phosphorus, so will not interfere with other nutritional inputs.
- Roots develop even in winter at $> 6^{\circ}\text{C}$.
- Increases natural resistance to insect and fungal attack.
- Very high micro-organism counts that enhance nutrient uptake with high humic content & natural fungistatic action.
- By providing a broad range of minor trace elements and essential minerals.
- At recommended application rates, Wormswork is completely safe for use on Australian native plants at all stages of growth and unlike PestOil™ does not defoliate woolly leaf plants.
